Annexure-I

Overall assessment of the visit and suggestions:

The panchayat Nanga is situated at the zero border line and most affected area during the cross border firing at the Indo-Pak Border. The people of the area are mostly dependent upon farming/ dairy farming for their survival. They are allotted with the custodian land but yet not given the property rights. Because of which, the public is devoid of any compensation, insurance, benefits on account of crop failure, floods, capturing of their land by BSF for fencing, cross border firing. People are regularly approaching the District Administration for their grievance and also raise this issue in the gram panchayat in every Back to village programme. The panchayat is otherwise found very calm with minimal crime rate, people living happily with each other.

The panchayat having three government middle schools at Nanga, Bakhan chak and Dadyal. After qualifying, the children has to move to tehsil headquarter Ramgarh for higher studies. Parents requested for upgrading the existing atleast one school or open new High/ Higher Secondary school in the panchayat so that students can get education at their doorstep.

Only 20% households are provided with the water connections. Public demanded for functional household tap connections and 100% coverage under Har ghar jal Scheme.

The Power supply is not upto the standard. People demanded for the upgradation of existing transformers to cater the whole area with sufficient volts.

Road connectivity with the tehsil headquarter is available and is in good condition but the internal lanes and drains are in very bad condition.

Bunkers are constructed in only 50% households in village Nanga only that too are incomplete in structures. All the six villages of the panchayat are situated at zero line and all are equally affected during cross border firing. So, bunkers should be constructed in all the other villages also viz Dadyal, Bamboo chak, Bakhan chak, Nathwal and Kandra of the panchayat on priority for the safety of the public.



There are two Health wellness centres in the panchayat , one Allopathic and one under AYUSH. The staff at AYUSH wellness centre is not sufficient , needs to be increased .

Only one Ration depot is there in the panchayat.

No bank branch, ATM Counter, khidmat centre / CSC is established in panchayat.

The panchayat ghar constructed is still in the possession of the land donor, who is stressing for providing job to his family member, in turn , only after that he will hand over the possession of panchayat ghar. The PRI members are operating their functions from the Hall constructed by the agriculture department.

As the panchayat Nanga is at zero border line, so the internet facility is minimal due to security reasons. People are unable to apply online for any scheme of the government .

The members of SHG found very active, the products prepared by them is also very classy. They requested for organizing some training programme for them and also establishment of marketing counter or village haat for selling their products.

No playground/ stadium is available in the panchayat, not even in the schools. People have identified a land at village Bamboo chak and Nanga near peer baba and requested for construction of playground for organising sports activities for youth of the area and protecting and diverting them from indulging in bad/ criminal activities .

The poor deserving beneficiaries requested for early sanctioning of financial assistance under PMAY scheme in their favour.

PRI members and general public found less aware about the various schemes. The officers/ officials were requested to organise mass awareness programme and facilitates them to avail the benefits .


There is no veterinary hospital in the panchayat , people is dependent upon farming and rearing cattles ,goats, sheet, poultry. Besides humans , animals are also equally affected or injured during the cross border firing. Due to non-availability of immediate veterinary services, cattles usually lost their lives.

Females, especially, requested for matador or bus service in the panchayat .

The cremation ground situated at the bank of basanter river at village Nanga was completely damaged during the floods in 2014. People requested to re-construct the cremation ground at the same place, which the Rural development department is denying with the apprehension that the same may again get destroyed during floods in future. The revenue department was requested to provide 3-4 marlas state or abandoned land for the construction of the same.

To pay homage one statue of Shaheed Capt. Bahadur Singh, Vir Chakra is installed at village Bamboo chak which needs a proper overshed to protect it from any damage caused due to rain, sunlight and dust.

Youth found least interested in self employment schemes after repeated counselling, motivation, lectures by the representatives of DIC, Bank, employment department. All the concerned officers/ officials were requested to organize the awareness camps for their motivation towards these schemes on regular basis.
