Comprehensive Overview of Panchayat Bhabore (District Doda) Visit and Successful Resolutions:

1. Irrigation Canal Repair:

- Identified a pressing issue with a crucial irrigation canal spanning 5 km from Rai to Maniana.
- Villagers previously assured of a submitted DPR for repair were growing anxious.
- Expedited resolution by urging the Block Development Officer to include critical repair under MGNREGA in the current financial year.
- Immediate action mitigated potential agricultural disruptions due to leakage.
- Ensured people to take up the matter for full upgradation with Irrigation and flood control wing of Jal Shakti department.

2. Drinking Water Supply:

- Acknowledged challenges in completing tendered projects for household water supply.
- Collaborated with the social forestry department to address obstacles.
- Executive Engineer, Jal Shakti department, committed to project completion by January 20, 2024.
- Ensured a reliable drinking water supply for the Panchayat, addressing both immediate and long-term concerns.

3. Electric Wire Utility Shifting

- Responded to community concerns about the utility shifting of low and high-tension electric wires.
- Facilitated a meeting with the JPDCL executive engineer to address safety and accessibility.
- Immediate resolution achieved by initiating the key cabling of low-tension wires and installing risers for high-tension wires. Cabling will be done by or before February 20, 2023.
- Enhanced safety, allowing for unhindered movement of vehicles and people.

4. Road Construction and Upgradation:

- Massive demands for the critical up-gradation of the existing 500m road to the high school in Bhabore.
- Addressed the need for administrative intervention to construct and upgrade roads leading to Jogi Mohalla and Nalkan Batote.
- Assured the community of pursuing these matters with R&B departments for comprehensive road development.

5. Government Scheme Accessibility:

- Responded to concerns about the inefficiency of the cooperative bank.
- Massive demand for the anchoring of government schemes in J&K Bank for

increased accessibility.

- Demanded the establishment of a bank branch within the Panchayat to streamline financial processes for residents.

6. Infrastructure Improvements

- Urged immediate measures for the installation of a safer bridge with two lanes on the depleted eastern ridge of the Badroon-Bhabore route.
- Recognized the potential risk to vehicles and residents in hilly terrain.
- Committed to taking up the matter with the administrative department to ensure a prompt and effective resolution.

7. School Infrastructure Enhancement

- Noted surplus infrastructure in the high school and proposed a strategic merger of a girls' primary school.
- Emphasized the transformation of the primary school building into a library.
- Pledged to take up the matter with Chief Education Officer, Doda and Mission Youth, Jammu and Kashmir, to ensure necessary merger and also infrastructure and resources for the library.

8. Park Development:

- Responded to the demand for a park in Dabral, inclusive of an open gym.
- Acknowledged the availability of land and committed to advocating for necessary upgrades.
- Assured the community of taking up the matter with the Deputy Commissioner Doda for comprehensive park development.
