However, schemes like Ayushman Bharat (SEHAT), PMAY-(G), Pension Schemes of the UT and the GoI are being quite effectively implemented. The Feedback of the people on the implementation of said schemes were positive. With regard to employment generation, it was observed that the economy of Panchayat has good scope for creating income generating units for the local youth and women. Mushroom Cultivation and Bamboo wood furniture are two activities that the Panchayat can excel in. Many local youth and women are already productively engaged in such works, Consequently Mushrooms and Bamboo furniture are being sent to the local market in the UT for sale. These two activities should be promoted by the sectoral departments for ensuring Self Employment for local youth and women. Overall development Scenario in the Panchayat is OK. However, infrastructure on the count of regular supply of Electricity, water, repairing of road etc. have

		to be ensured. The Panchayat needs a good playground and also the monkey menace needs to be addressed.
