In the said meeting it was also decided to have 1/2 Dustbins installed in each ward of different public places. Hence the ward wise site selection for Primary Collection Centre. This was also done by the sub-committee in the Gram Sabha which is as under.

- i) Ward No 01 at Pyl. Ghar.
- ii) Ward No 02 at at Gulzar Shop.
- iii) Ward No 03 at Sham Lal Shop.
- iv) Ward No 04 at ByPass Se Moh.
- v) Ward No 05 at Dhalwan Chowk.
- vi) Ward No 06 at H/School Dhalwan
- vii) Ward No 07 at Thakur Mahale

Beside it, in the Gram Sabha the committee also decide to have segregation waste plant in the Panchayat for which WMO-04 and WMO-07 lower Dhalwan has been selected by the said committee.

In addition to this, the total population of Pyl Dhalwan is near about 2600. It consists of 07 wards and about 460 households. There are 04 Govt Schools and 03 Anganwadi Centres, a Pyl. Ghar and a Health Wellness Centre in this Panchayat Dhalwan. Hence the process of the Gram Sabha comes to an end.
