Annexure - I

The following monthly fee structure to levy and collect user fee for Management of Management from various waste generators shall be implemented across all Halga pvt.

- 1) Households
 - a) INR 100 per month
- 2) Shops and Commercial Establishments
 - a) up to 500 sq. ft — INR 100 per month
 - b) > 500 sq. ft or more — INR 200 per month
- 3) Restaurants, Eateries and Meat Shops.
 - a) up to 500 sq. ft — INR 200 per month
 - b) > 500 sq. ft or more — INR 400 per month
- 4) Hotels and Lodging
 - a) INR 500 per month + additional fees on restaurants
- 5) Government | private offices Banks, police station and office establishments.

- a) INR 200 per month
- b) Hospitals and health care centre
- a) INR 500 per month
- 7) Educational Institutions:
 - a) INR 200 per month
 - b) Residential institutions (Schools, colleges etc)
 - a) INR 500 per month
- 9) Industries for Non hazardous waste) Including cold storages, godown etc.
 - a) Micro Industries - 200/month
 - b) small Industries - 500/month
 - c) Medium industries - 1000/month
 - d) Large industries - 2000/month
- 10) Marriage Halls, exhibitions, bus stands and places.
 - 10000 / events.
