RESOLUTION

Today as on 16/10/2022 a special meeting of PRI members of Panchayat Chak Agor Block R.S. Pura was held under the chairmanship of Sarpanch <sup>Shri</sup> Apna Devi. The Agenda of meeting was regarding passing of specific by-laws in content of management of solid waste generated in the Panchayat and their subsequent adoption. In addition to adoption of by-laws regarding solid waste management the PRI members also agreed for constitution of Halqa level Sanitation Committee.

The following monthly fee structure has been purposed in context of levying on collection as user fee for management of SWM; from various waste generators across the Halqa Panchayat.

1. Household : →  
(a) Rs 100/- Month
2. Shops and Commercial Establishments :  
(a) up to 500 Square ft — Rs 100/Month (Hundred Rupees)  
(b) > 500 Sq. ft — Rs 200/Month (Two Hundred Rupees)
3. Hostels and Lodging :  
(a) Rs 500/month + additional fees on restaurants and eateries on their premises.
4. Restaurants, Eateries and Meat Shops :  
Up to 500 Sq. ft — Rs 200/Month  
> 500 Sq. ft — Rs 400/Month
5. Govt/Private offices, Banks, Police station and offices :  
(a) Rs 200/month

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Hospitals & Health care Institutions:

(a) Rs 500/Month

Educational Institutions:

(a) Rs 200/Month

Residential Institutions (School, Colleges etc)

(a) Rs 200/Month

Industries [For non-Hazardous waste] including cold storage godowns etc.

(a) Micro Industries — Rs 200/Month

(b) Small Industries — Rs 500/Month

(c) Medium Industries — Rs 1000/Month

(d) Large Industries — Rs 2000/Month

Marriage Halls, Haats, Exhibition, bus stand and Places of mass Assembly:-

(a) Rs 1000/Month

Proposed Penalty Provision

A meeting of the Halqa Panchayat committee on Solid waste Management shall be convened every month to decide & levy a one time fine on the offenders for littering or burning of wastes.
