

Solid Waste Management

Resolution

Today on 20/10/22 a special meeting of PRI's of Panchayat, Samka, Block. R.S. Pura was held under the Chairmanship of Sarpanch Sh. Balkar Singh. The agenda of the meeting was regarding passing of specific by-laws in context of management of Solid waste generated in the Panchayat and their subsequent adoption. In addition to adoption of by-laws regarding Solid waste management the PRI members also agreed for constitution of Halqa level Sanitation committee.

The following monthly fee structure has been proposed in context of levying collection as user fee for management of SWM, from various waste generators across the Halqa Panchayat.

1. Households :-

(a) Rs 100/- per month.

2. Shops and commercial Establishments :-

(a) upto 500 Sq.ft. - Rs 100/- per month

(b) More than 500 Sq.ft. - Rs 200/- per month.

3. Hostels and Lodging :-

(a) Rs. 500/- per month + additional fee on restaurants and eateries in their premises.

4. Restaurants and Eateries and Meat Shops :-

(a) upto 500 Sq.ft. - Rs 200/- per month

(b) more than 500 Sq.ft - Rs 400/- per month

5. Govt/Private offices, Banks, Police stations and office establishments :-

(a) Rs. 200/- per month

Constitution of Sanitation Committee

Today 20/10/2022 a meeting of Gram Sabha was held under the chairmanship of Sarpanch Sh. Balkar Singh in the Panchayat Ghar, Samka. Regarding the formulation Solid waste management Committee in the Panchayat Halqa. All the present participants have discussed the matter and finally decided that, they will provide the list after discussing with the households living in the Panchayat Samita and submit to higher authorities the same.

Identification of land for Segregation of waste in Panchayat Halqa Samita.

Another agenda point regarding requirement of State land for waste Segregation was also discussed in the meeting. After long discussion all the members told that, State land is not available in Panchayat. So, all members were of the view that, if revenue department will provide land for ^{the} Solid waste Segregation, then Segregation of waste will take place at the Govt. land.

RUDA Agency

The 4th Agenda of meeting was discussed regarding the list of vehicles and owner drivers who will collect the waste from door steps of the Panchayat households. After discussions, It was decided the 'RUDA' will be the agency which will collect the waste from the household of Panchayat Samita. 'RUDA' agency is Selected by the Panchayat for Solid waste management System.

Proposed Penalty Provision.

A meeting of the Halga Panchayat committee on solid waste management shall be convened every month to decide and levy a one time fine on the offenders for littering or burning of wastes :-
