BYE-LAWS For Solid Waste Management in The Halga Panchayat Baran Block - Bhalwal.

1. Short Title and Commencement!

These Bye-Laws may be called The 'Bye-Laws for Solid Waste Management in The Halga Panchayat Baran Block Bhalwal Distt. Jammu 2022

2 Application of the Bye-Laws

These Bye-Laws Shall be applicable to every area falling Under the Halga Panch. boundary of Panchayat Baran Block Bhalwal and every domestic, institutional, Commercial and any other non-residential Solid Waste management generator Situated in The area except industrial waste, hazardous waste, hazardous chemicals, bio medical waste, e-waste, lead acid batteries and radio-activity waste That Covered Under Separate Rules.

3. Definitions

In These Bye-Laws unless and Context Otherwise requires:

(a) "Solid Waste" means and includes Solid or Semi-Solid, domestic, Solid Waste, Sanitary Waste, Commercial Waste, institutional Waste, Catering and market Waste and Other non-residential Waste, Street Waste, institutional Waste, and Other non-residential Waste, Street Sweepings Still removed or Collected from The Surface drains, horticulture Waste, Agricultural and dairy Waste, treated bio, medical Waste excluding industrial Waste, bio-medical Waste and e-waste, battery Waste radio, Waste, generated in The area Under The Local Authorities.

(b) "Bio-degradable Waste" means any Organic material That Can be degraded by micro-Organisms into Simpler Stable Compounds

(c) "Bye-Laws" means regulatory framework notified by The Halga Panchayat for facilitating The implementation of These rules effectively in Their jurisdictions.

(d) "Composting" means a Controlled Process involving microbial decomposition of Organic matter.

(e) "Disposal" means The final and Safe disposal of Refuse Process

residual Solid Waste and insect Street Sweepings and Slit from Surface drains on land to prevent Contamination of ground Water Surface, ambient air and attraction of animals or birds.

(F) "Dry-Waste" means waste and other than bio-degradable waste and insect Street Sweepings and includes recyclable and non-recyclable waste, Combustible waste and Sanitary napkin and diapers etc.

(g) "Facility" means any establishment where the Solid waste, management processes namely Segregation, recovery, Storage, Collection, recycling, Processing, Treatment or safe disposal are carried out.

(h) "Inerts" means wastes which are not bio-degradable, recyclable or Combustible Street Sweeping or dust and Slit removed from the Surface drains.

(i) "Non-bio-degradable" waste means any waste that cannot be degraded by microorganisms into simpler stable compounds.

(j) "Processing" means any scientific process by which Segregated Solid Waste is handled for the purpose of reuse, recycling or transformation into new products.

(k) "Recycling" means the process of transforming Segregated non-bio-degradable Solid Waste into new material or product or as raw material for producing new products which may or may not be similar to the original products.

(l) "Sanitary waste" means waste comprising of used diapers, sanitary towels or napkins, tampons, condoms, incontinence sheet and any other similar waste.

(m) "Treatment" means the method, technique or process designed to modify physical, chemical or biological characteristics or composition of any waste so as to reduce its volume and potential cause harm.

(n) "User Fee" means a fee imposed by the Local Panchayat on the waste generators to cover full or part cost of providing Solid

Waste Collection, transportation, Processing and disposal Services.

(O) "Vermi Composting". means the process of Conversion bio-degradable waste into Compost using earth worms.

(P) "Waste Generator" means and includes Every Person or group of People every residential premise and Non-residential establishment including Govt organisations which generate Solid Waste.

(Q) "EO-Guard" means a person or groups of people informally engaged in Collection & recovery of recyclable Solid Waste from the Source of Waste generation through bins material recovery facilities, Processing and waste disposal facilities for sale to recycle directly or through intermediaries to earn their livelihoods.

Words and expressions used herein but not defined, but defined in The Environment Protection Act 1986 The Water Prevention and Control of Pollution,

Act 1974 Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Cess Act 1977 and The air (Prevention of Control of Pollution) Act 1981 Solid-Waste management rules 2016 guide line on Solid & Liquid Waste management SLM in rural Areas, 2014 shall have the same meaning as assigned to them in the respective Acts and rules and their subsequent amendments.
