

Comm Secry RDD visits Baltal; Takes stock of sanitation arrangements in view of upcoming SANJY-2022

GANDERBAL: Commissioner Secretary, Rural Development Department (RDD) and Panchayati Raj, Mandeep Kaur today had an extensive tour of Baltal in order to have first-hand appraisal of the sanitation measures put in place by the department in view ensuing Shri Amarnath Ji Yatra (SANJY)-2022.
