DDC Kupwara reviews implementation of Mission Amrit Sarovars

KUPWARA, JUNE 24: The District Development Commissioner (DDC), Kupwara, Khalid Jahangir today convened a meeting of concerned officers to review the progress achieved under Mission Amrit Sarovars for construction and rejuvenation of water bodies, Ponds and Storage Tanks across the district.

The meeting discussed threadbare various issues related to successful achievement of the Mission Amrit Sarovars. The DDC reviewed all aspects and received feedback from the concerned officers.
