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Today on 07 November 2022, Gram Sabha was held at Panchayat Ghar Dher under the chairmanship of Sh. Ravi Kumar Sharma Sarpanch Panchayat Dher in which PRI members and frontline workers made their presence as per order issued by Honable Deputy District Development Commissioner, Kathua Sh. Rahul Pandey.

Main Agenda of Meeting:- Preparation of Gram Panchayat Development Plan

The meeting starts with a awareness about Monthly meeting of Panchayat in which all Inline departments needs to participate and help in the formulation of GPDP.

Various demands come to the notice of Panchayat and action regarding them was expected from them. Some of them were:-

- (a) Requirement of new Electric Poles.
- (b) Completion of Wiring work on already installed Poles.
- (c) Repair of Water pipes installed in Multi School.
- (d) Road from BEd. College (Dewal) to WNo.2 and Cluster of Roads at Phinter Chowk.
- (e) Salary of Chowkidar is pending since 18 months and disbursement of the same needs to be expected.
- (f) Plantation work should be done more frequently.
- (g) Sarpanch, Pti. Dher also raised the issue of Poor Performance of Patwaris.
- (h) Cleaning of Canal at Gahr Mohalla (WNo.2) was raised.
- (i) Rate of admission of Children in Anganwadi work is low in past few months.

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- (j) Need of Boundary Wall and land labelling in almost all the Schools.
 - (k) Lack of Water Supply in school's toilet which makes it non-functional.
 - (l) Shortage of Staff in Primary Schools.
 - (m) Construction of Culvert in WNO-5 near house of Bantik and others.

After that awareness about Golden Health Card was made by Health and Family Welfare department and awareness about Mandi was made by Agriculture Department and urged people to sell their crop in the Mandi established. After that awareness about agriculture shop was made by Agriculture Department. He urged people to sell their produce in the same shop and that will be sold in Jurn to people after packaging.

Among all the people present here, some of inline workers were absent. Among them were Flood Control Department, Horticulture department, Food Civil Suppliers and Consumer Affairs department, Industries and Commerce Deptt, Floriculture Department, Skill Development Department, REWS Department.

Among all PRIs, only Panch of WNO-1, Panch of WNO-2, Panch of WNO-4, Panch of WNO-5, Panch of WNO-8 and Sarpanch (Pyl. Dhr) were present during the meeting.
